ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, Government have issued orders on the guidelines governing the implementation of the Focus Blocks Development Programme (Priority Blocks including Hill area regions) as Annexure I along with the list of 187 Key Development Indicators (KDIs) as Annexure II.

- 2. In the letter read above, the Member Secretary (FAC), State Planning Commission has informed that revision of Key Development Indicators is necessitated based on the following observations in the minutes of the review meeting convened by the Chief Secretary held on 17.04.2024, regarding Focus Blocks Development Programme:
 - i) restrict the Key Development Indicators between 22 to 30.
 - ii) study monitoring, outcomes and incremental improvement.
 - iii) provide incentives to one or two blocks every month based on better performance / incremental improvement in indicators [The incentive be decided by the Committee].

- 3. In the reference second read above, the Member Secretary (FAC), State Planning Commission has submitted proposal with the restricted and revised list of Key Development Indicators [50]. The revised Key Development Indicators have been reorganized into sub themes and sub indicators consisting of 50 indicators with sub indicators under each.
 - 4. After careful examination the following orders are passed:
 - i) Blocks are to be ranked on the basis of performance of progress achieved in the Key Development Indicators (KDIs) and the Schemes mapped with Key Development Indicators.
 - ii) The Monitoring Framework is to be used to monitor the implementation of schemes that have been mapped with the sub-indicators and also Ranking Framework to be used to rank the Block in terms of relative performances of the focus blocks in a periodic manner and to reward the best performing Blocks.
- 5. Revised list of the 50 Key Development Indicators as against the original 187 Key Development Indicators is appended as Annexure to this order.

The expression "187 Key Development Indicators" in the Government Order first read above shall be substituted by the expression "50 Key Development Indicators". The Annexure of the list 50 Key Development Indicators appended to this Government Order shall be read as Annexure-II to the Government Order first read above.
